DOGS MAY ARRIVE AT ANY TIME PRIOR TO SCHEDULED TIME OF JUDGING. DOGS NOT REQUIRED FOR FURTHER JUDGING WILL BE EXCUSED. Puppy class winners, Bred by Exhibitor class winners are reminded that additional competition for Best in Puppy Classes, Best Bred by Exhibitor Classes will follow Best of Breed judging.

### CONSULT JUDGING PROGRAM FOR TIME OF JUDGING.

JUDGES ARE NOT REQUIRED TO WAIT FOR DOGS. THEY WILL ADHERE AS CLOSELY AS POSSIBLE TO THE JUDGING SCHEDULE. Owners or agents alone are responsible for the presence of their dog in the judging ring when their classes are called to be judged. The Potomac Afghan Hound Club and the Show Secretary have no obligation or responsibility for providing service through a public address system or steward or runners for the purpose of calling or locating dogs that are not brought into the ring when required.

**ALL DOGS PRESENT MUST BE HELD ON LEASH** or confined to their crates except when being judged.

**NO GASOLINE OR DIESEL GENERATORS** are permitted within 100 feet of the tent or show ring.

CASH PRIZES WILL BE PAID IN THE RING TO THE PERSON SHOWING THE DOG. Claims for cash prize money must be made in the show ring before judging is over for the show. The Potomac Afghan Hound Club and the Show Secretary disclaim any liability for cash prizes after the judging of the show is over.

**ENTRY FEES** shall not be refunded in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, excused by the judge or barred from competition by action of the Show Committee. If, because of riots, civil disturbances, or other acts beyond the control of the management, it is impossible to complete the show, no refund of the entry fee will be made.

# OWNERS ARE RESPONSIBLE FOR ERRORS IN MAKING OUT ENTRY FORMS

No Entry Fees for Parade of Veterans or Parade of Rescue Dogs

Entries can be taken on the website of the Potomac Afghan Hound Club. There is a separate fee charged by PayPal to use their services. This will appear as a 'Shipping & Handling Fee' via our website. When making your online entry payment, please submit your entry form directly to the Show Secretary at bestafghan@comcast.net while submitting your payment through PayPal.

## Non-Regular Classes Involving Multiple Dog Entries

Stud Dog Class – For Stud Dogs and at least two, and not more than four of their Get. It is not necessary that the Get be under the same ownership as that of the Stud Dog. The Stud Dog may be entered in one of the Regular or Non-Regular Classes or, if a Champion of Record, in Best of Breed competition, but must be entered in the Stud Dog class. The Stud Dog may be entered in the Stud Dog Class only at the regular entry fee. The Get must be entered in one of the Regular Classes or, if a Champion of Record, in Best of Breed competition. The Stud Dog shall be considered one entry and requires one entry fee. The Stud Dog must be shown in the ring with the Get. The class will be judged based on the merits of the Get. While the merits of the Stud Dog are not to be considered in the placement of the entry, the Stud Dog must be examined to determine if it has a condition that would require its disqualification or excusal under the dog show rules, AKC policy, or the standard of the breed. Entry Fee is \$15.

**Brood Bitch Class** - same as for Stud Dog except substitute Brood Bitch for Stud Dog and Produce for Get. **Entry Fee is \$15.** 

\*Chapter 11, Sec on 8 of the "Rules Applying to Dog Shows" provides that a neutered male may be entered as a Stud Dog in the Stud Dog Class and a spayed Bitch may be entered as a Brood Bitch in the Brood Bitch Class.

As the judge's decision in the Stud Dog, Brood Bitch, and Brace classes will be based on the merits of more than one dog or bitch, no one of the dogs or bitches making up the entry judged first in the class will be eligible to compete for Best of Breed by virtue of having won either of these classes.

**Best Puppy**: Open to the dogs and bitches placing first in the regular puppy classes. **No additional entry fee is required.** 

**Best Bred-By-Exhibitor**: Open to the dog and bitch placing first in the regular Bred-By-Exhibitor classes. **No additional entry fee is required.** 

**Veteran Class: (Competitive):** Open to all dogs and bitches (Champions and Non-Champions) who, on the date of the show, are 7 years of age or older. Sexes will be divided, and first place in each class will be eligible to compete for Best of Breed. **Entry fee is \$33.00.** 

Parade of Veterans (Non-Competitive): Open to all dogs and bitches (Champions and Non-Champions) who, on the day of the show, are 7 years of age or older. A Sash with the Potomac Afghan Hound Club's logo will be awarded. No entry fee. Entries in this class may not be entered in any other class at the specialty.

Parade of Rescue Dogs (Non-Competitive): Open to all Afghan Hounds, dogs or bitches rescued and adopted into loving homes. Please pass this premium list to those people that you know have adopted rescue Afghans and, further, encourage them to fill out a rescue entry form and join us at the specialty. A rosette and certificate of participation will be presented to each entrant. No entry fee.

Please note: Entrants in both the Parade of Veterans and the Parade of Rescue Dogs classes please complete the bio/comments sheet found in the premium list. Completion of this form will greatly facilitate the presentation of our Parade of Veterans and Parade of Rescue Dogs and ensure that we give them the recognition that they deserve. Rescue dog entrants, please use the AKC entry form. It is not necessary that all of the blanks be filled in. Just supply the data that you have. Class will be "Parade of Rescue Dogs".

- 2. The following categories of dogs may be entered and shown in Best of Breed competition: Dogs that are Champions of Record and dogs which, according to their owners' records, have completed the requirements for a championship, but whose championships are unconfirmed. The showing of unconfirmed Champions in Best of Breed competition is limited to a period of 90 days from the date of the show where the dog completed the requirements for a championship.
- 3. (Event Class) Consult the classification in this premium list. If the event class in which you are entering your dog is divided, then, in addition to designating the class, specify the particular division of the class in which you are entering your dog, i.e. age division, color division, weight division.
- 4. A dog must be entered in the name of the person who actually owned it at the time entries for an event closed. If a registered dog has been acquired by a new owner it must be entered in the name of its new owner in any event for which entries closed after the date of acquirement, regardless of whether the new owner has received the registration certificate indicating that the dog is recorded in his name.
